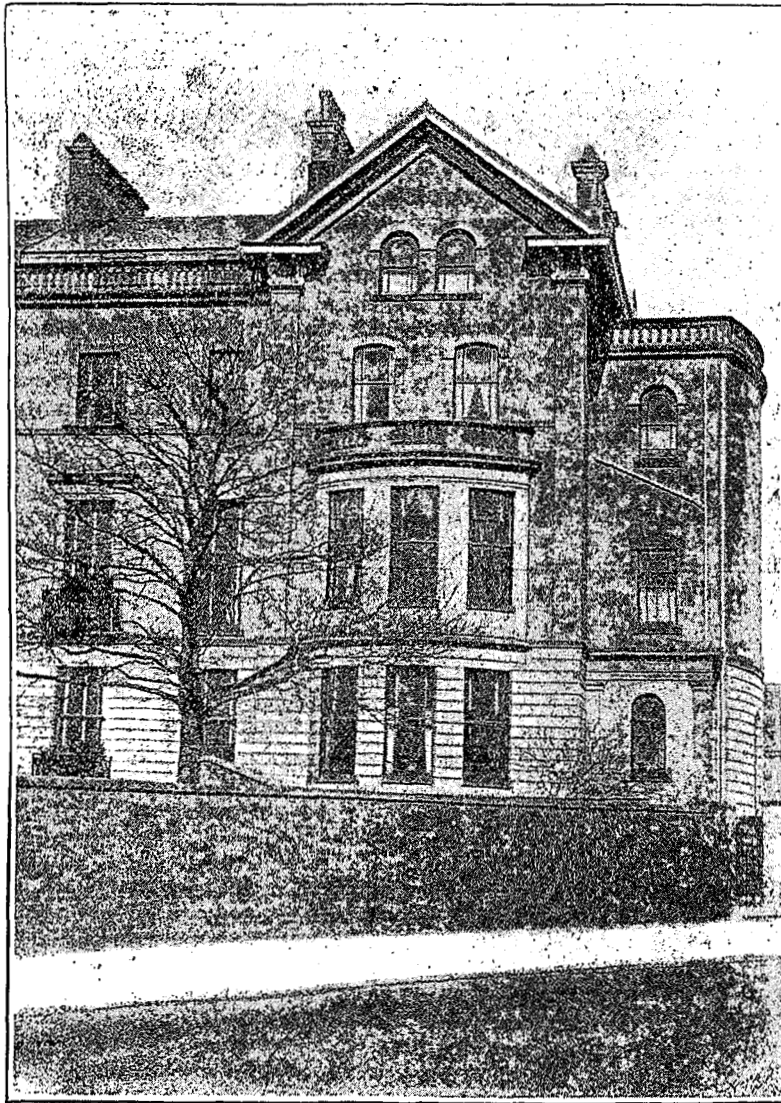


OUR INSTITUTIONS:
A RECORD OF THEIR OBJECTS AND WORK.

THE SCARBOROUGH TRAINED NURSES'
INSTITUTE AND HOME HOSPITAL.

THIS Institution, which was opened some two years ago, has recently been trans-

ferred to much more commodious premises. The pleasant little house at first taken was found to be quite inadequate for the number of patients, and for the Nursing staff when at home; and although the owner of the house very kindly suggested enlarging the place, which could easily have been done, it was decided that it would be best to move a little nearer the town; accordingly a very large house in Falsgrave Road has been chosen. It is very pleasantly situated, with a south aspect, and in every way suitable for the purpose of receiving patients. There are two suites of rooms with doors communicating one with the other, and these are furnished very prettily as
