In March, the application was duly made, and simultaneously a great Meeting was held at the Mansion House in its support. The time has not yet arrived to tell the history of the movement in full detail, but it is a matter of common knowledge that a very large number of important Hospitals, and many hundreds of medical men living in all parts of the United Kingdom, came forward to give their testimony and assistance in
