THE SAMARITAN DEPARTMENT, 55, Weymouth Street, Portland Place, is open every week day except Saturday at 1.30, and on Wednesday evening at 6 o'clock. Free to the Destitute; others contribute a small sum. The Patients of the West End Hospital, which Dr. Tibbitts founded in 1878, under the Patronage of the PRINCESS OF WALES, and the Presidency of the late DUKE OF BUCCLEUCH, are now invited to transfer themselves to his care at the above Massage Hospital.
