able to the mouth, purifying and sweetening to the breath. This dentifrice is "put up" in bottles with the "sprinkle stoppers," so that there need not be any waste. The Carboline Toothbrush, specially introduced by Mr. E. Pearson, is a durable and sensible little article. The bristles are of uneven length, while the distance between the "batches" of bristles where they are placed in their sockets does not permit of water accumulating and destroying their roots. They retail at one shilling each, and should find their place on every washstand.
