Salaries, Matron £100, Sisters £30 to £40, Nurses £22, Probationers' 1st year nil, then £12, £20. Holidays, Sisters 1 month, Nurses and Probationers 3 weeks yearly.

BRIDGEWATER INFIRMARY.—Established 1813. 40 beds. Nursing Staff—Matron, Mrs. Okell, 2 Nurses, and 4 Probationers.
