REPLIES TO CORRESPONDENTS.

A Trained Nurse.—There are excellent opportunities in private practice for a trained Nurse who has had, in addition, experience in Insane Asylums. Excellent salaries ranging from £100 to £170 a year are gained by skilful Mental Attendants on the well-to do. Of course the work is specially trying, for which reason it is better paid. As you state that your Nerves are "made of iron" you ought to stand the strain excellently well. But we hope your sympathies are not made of a material to match your nerves.

Miss E. Brown.—See answer to above *re* Asylum Attendants' prospects. You could easily, with a little economy, manage on the salary you would gain in the first year as an Asylum Attendant. The salaries range from £17 a year, going up to £35. But as you have had such splendid Hospital training you would not need more than one year's experience in an Asylum. With that you should be perfectly equipped for a Mental Attendant to a private case.

Miss Elder.—Probably the drink you refer to is what is called the gum-arabic drink. It is made by dissolving an ounce of pure gum-arabic in a pint of boiling water, adding two tablespoons of sugar, a wine-glass of sherry, and the juice of a large lemon. Cool, and add ice. It is very advisable for a Nurse in private practice to keep a recipe book, and note down all and every fresh dish and invalid dainty with which she comes in contact.

Would-be District Nurse.—You can obtain special training in district work from the Metropolitan and National Nursing Association, Bloomsbury Square, London, W.C., from the Queen Victoria Jubilee Institute, or the Leicester, Manchester, or Glasgow Associations.
