The number of subjects which were discussed were necessarily limited by other demands upon our time, notably those involved by the work of the Nursing Exhibition. With reference to more than one of these discussions, we are led to hope that further practical results may follow the publication of the papers which were read; but in any case the Meeting is of much interest from an historical point of view. In all other professions, it is the custom to hold public Conferences in order that the members may freely discuss matters affecting their work, and it was time that the example should be followed in the
