EXTRACT FROM THE LAST ANNUAL REPORT.

"During 1895, there were 254 Nurses and visitors admitted. On the average, each one stayed in the Home for fifteen days, and throughout the whole twelve months there were on the average nearly ten resident in the house. It will, however, be observed that considerably increased assistance in the shape of annual subscriptions and donations is much required. The payments which Nurses can afford to make have been, as they probably always will be, insufficient to cover the entire expenses. The Committee therefore very earnestly appeals for further donations and annual subscriptions to make up the necessary deficiency."

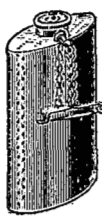
