

Editorial.

LICENSED NURSES.

A SUGGESTION is now being discussed in the medical press which deserves the most careful consideration of nurses, as it may prove to be the germ of a novel system of professional organization and control. In order to explain it fully, it must be remembered that the greatest dissatisfaction exists in the medical profession concerning the system of registration enforced upon medical practitioners.

In order to obtain a legal qualification to practice, a medical man must spend five years in close and continuous study at a recognised medical college and hospital. He must pass successfully certain examinations in the different subjects of his curriculum, and finally, he obtains a diploma or degree according to the college or the university with which he is connected. He is then, in the eye of the law, licensed to practice as a medical practitioner. But for the protection of the public, Parliament has ordained that if he desires to be recognised by the State as a medical practitioner, and to be enabled to recover his fees for medical attend-
