## Editorial.

### THE PROFESSIONAL CONGRESS.

WE described last week, the history and progress of the International Council of Women, and the formation of the various National Councils of the different countries which it is proposed should be affiliated and united to the International body.

We pass on now to a preliminary description of the Section of the forthcoming congress of women which will be of chief interest to our readers. As we explained, the Congress will be divided into six sections, of which the third is "Professional," the others being devoted to subjects connected with International Arbitration, Education, Politics, Industrial and Social organisations.

Each of the Sections is divided into Departments, each of the latter having a representative on the Committee which arranges the affairs of the Section. The Departments of the Professional Section will be those relating to Medicine, Nursing, Art, Journalism, Teaching, the Civil Service, etc.

For the moment, we would confine ourselves to considering the organization of the International Nursing Congress, which will thus be held under the auspices of the International Council next year. Several days will be devoted to the meetings of the Congress for the reading and discussion of papers on matters
