Candidates for the Preliminary Examination must complete the prescribed period of training by the last day of June. Candidates for the Final Examination must have attained the required age and have completed the prescribed period of training by the last day of June.

In no circumstances may a candidate change her Centre after April 21st, 1955.

**HEALTH VISITOR BURSARY**

Applications are invited from State Registered Nurses not over 34 years of age, holding the Certificate of the Central Midwives Board or the first certificate under the new C.M.B. rules, to become STUDENT HEALTH VISITORS under a scheme of training beginning in September, 1955. The training may be taken in London or in Birmingham. Training continues to the end of June, 1956.

During that time, the Corporation will pay 75 per cent. of the minimum salary laid down in the Whitley Council's recommendations, the fees for the course and outdoor uniform.
