LAST day for applying for Entry Forms, Tuesday  
July 21st, 1953.

These dates do not apply to candidates who were  
present at the June, 1953, Examinations (see foot-  
note).

LAST day for sending in completed Entry Forms,  
Tuesday, July 28th, 1953.

Applications for forms should not be made by tele-  
phone, and forms must not be called for unless  
previous notification is given of the number required.  
Letters of application for forms should not contain  
reference to other subjects, as this may cause delay  
in dealing with the application.

Candidates for the Preliminary Examination must  
complete the prescribed period of training by the last  
day of October. Candidates for the Final Examina-  
tion must have attained the required age and have  
completed the prescribed period of training by the  
last day of October.

In no circumstances may a candidate change her  
Centre after August 26th, 1953.
