# The General Nursing Council for England and Wales.

A MEETING OF THE General Nursing Council for England and Wales was held at the offices of the Council, 23, Portland Place, London, W.1, on Friday, 23rd September, 1955.

#### Election of Chairman.

The first business on the Agenda was the election of Chairman. As there had been only one nomination, Miss M. J. Smyth, Vice-Chairman, became the Chairman of the General Nursing Council.

### Death of Sir Ralph Picken.

News was received, with regret, of the death of a former member of the General Nursing Council-Sir Ralph Picken. He was appointed by the Minister of Health and served from 1930-1945, and from 1950-1953. He was an ardent supporter of the One Portal entry by nurses into the profession.

#### Election of Vice-Chairman.
