Appointment of STUDENT HEALTH VISITORS.

Applications are invited from State Registered Nurses under 35 years of age who desire to train as HEALTH VISITORS. Candidates must have Part I Midwifery Certificate, and on successful completion of the course of training will be required to enter into an agreement to serve the Council for a period of two years. The posts are superannuable and subject to passing a medical examination.

The course commences in September, 1955, at Bolton. Successful applicants may be offered temporary employment as clinic nurses until the opening of the course.

Salary as a student will be £315 per annum, plus £9 uniform allowance. After qualifying Health Visitors are paid in accordance with the recommendations of the Nurses and Midwives Whitley Council, and uniform is provided.

The Council will bear the cost of tuition fees, examination fees and travelling expenses. One-third of these costs will be repaid by the student to the Corporation by instalments spread over six months.
