Applications for forms should be addressed to the Registrar, The General Nursing Council for England and Wales, P.O. Box No. 803, 23, Portland Place, London, W.1. Applications for forms should not be made by telephone, and forms must not be called for unless previous notification is given of the number required. Letters of application for forms should not contain reference to other subjects, as this may cause delay in dealing with the application.

Candidates for the Preliminary Examination must complete the prescribed period of training by the last day of October. Candidates for the Final Examination must have attained the required age and have completed the prescribed period of training by the last day of October.

In no circumstances may a candidate change her Centre after August 24th, 1955.

RESULTS.—The results of the examination will be published at the end of November, 1955.

Candidates who were present at and completed that Examination should apply for the October forms not earlier than July 23rd, 1955, and not later than July 27th, 1955. NOTICE OF ELECTION, 1955.

NURSES ACT, 1949.

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to the Nurses Act, 1949, an election of two registered mental nurses as members of the MENTAL NURSES COMMITTEE OF THE GENERAL NURSING COUNCIL FOR ENGLAND AND WALES, to represent registered mental nurses, is about to be held.

In order to be eligible for election or to be entitled to nominate for and take part in the election, a person must be a registered mental nurse (which term includes a registered nurse for mental defectives) on the date of the election.

Each candidate must be nominated on a separate nomination paper, and no person may nominate more than two candidates.

Every nomination paper must contain the name, address and registered qualifications of the candidate nominated; it must be signed by not fewer than six persons having the requisite qualifications for nominating the candidate; and the address and registered qualifications of each one so signing must be appended to his or her signature.

The nomination paper must be accompanied by a declaration in writing signed by the person nominated, acknowledging that he or she consents to be nominated, and must be delivered by post or otherwise, before the hour of twelve noon on the 5th day of September, 1955, addressed to the Returning Officer, The General Nursing Council for England and Wales, 23, Portland Place, London, W.1, from whom forms of nomination papers may, on application by post or otherwise, be obtained.

Every nomination paper which is not received at the address given above before the hour of twelve noon on the 5th day of September, 1955, will be invalid.
