Editorial.

THE NURSING EXHIBITION AND CONFERENCE.

HE arrangements for these are now practically completed, and we hope, next week, to give our readers a complete programme of the proceedings which will take place at St. Martin's Town Hall from June 1st to June 13th. There are, however, a few details concerning which some information may with advantage be given, at once. So far as the Exhibition goes, it is divided into two separate parts, the first being a systematic exhibit of appliances employed in the care of the sick and injured, while a second Hall is devoted to some of the many valuable productions of a few leading manufacturers.
