ASSISTANT MATRON wanted.—The Guardians of the Hamlet of Mile End Old Town require the services of an Assistant Matron at their Infirmary on the Workhouse premises in Bancroft Road, Mile End Road, London, E.

The person appointed will have to take the entire charge of the nursing staff, and be responsible for the proper discharge of their duties.

She will have to train the probationer nurses in the office of nursing, and prepare them for passing examinations in nursing, and she will have to assist the Matron in the general work of the Infirmary, and to perform such other duties as the Guardians may, from time to time, prescribe.

She must have received, at least, three years' training as a nurse in a general hospital or workhouse infirmary.

The vacancy has arisen through the present holder of the office having been appointed Infirmary Matron elsewhere.

The salary commences at £40 per annum, with board, lodging, washing, and uniform, and an allowance of twopence per day in lieu of beer.
