#### SUPERINTENDENT NURSE.

BEDWELLY UNION.—SUPER-  
INTENDENT NURSE Wanted.—  
The Guardians of the Bedwelly Union  
require the services of a Superintendent  
Nurse at their Workhouse, who has under-  
gone for three years at least a course of  
instruction in the medical and surgical  
wards of any hospital or infirmary being a  
training school for nurses, and maintaining  
a resident or house-surgeon.
