**CHARGE NURSES.**

**HACKNEY UNION.—CHARGE  
NURSE WANTED.**

The Guardians of this Union will, at  
their meeting, to be held on Wednesday,  
May 10th, 1899, proceed to the election of  
a Charge Nurse for the Infirmary of their  
schools at Brentwood, Essex.

Salary £30 per annum, rising £1 annually  
to a maximum salary of £36 per annum  
together with rations, washing, lodging,  
and uniform clothing.

The appointment will be subject to the  
provisions of the Poor Law Officers' Super-  
annuation Act, 1896, the Amendment Act,
