SUPERINTENDENT NURSE.

PARISH OF BRIGHTON.—Appointment of SUPERINTENDENT NURSE.

The Guardians of the above parish invite applications for the appointment of a SUPERINTENDENT NURSE at their workhouse.

The appointment will be made subject to the approval of the Local Government Board and to the provisions of the Poor Law Officers' Superannuation Act, 1896, and the Amendment Act, 1897.

Candidates must be single women or widows, and must be qualified for the appointment by having undergone for three years a course of instruction in the medical and surgical wards of a hospital or infirmary being a training school for nurses, and maintaining a resident physician or house surgeon, and must also be certificated in midwifery.

Salary £70 per annum, with rations (except beer), furnished apartments, washing, and indoor uniform. The value of the emoluments of the office for the purpose of superannuation is fixed at £50 per annum.
