**Editorial.**

THE INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS OF WOMEN.

**D**URING the coming week, members of the Nursing Profession in this country will have the opportunity and privilege of meeting and hearing the views of leading women in their profession of other nations, and of international comparison of their methods of work. The value of the occasion from an educational point of view cannot be overestimated, and we owe it to the fact that the International Council of Women have arranged their meeting in London this year. This is an opportunity not likely to occur again in the lifetime of many of us, as the large number of countries which now have National Councils affiliated with the International Council will, no doubt, be desirous of entertaining the International Council in turn. Those therefore who have availed themselves of the advantage thus afforded to them at the present time are to be congratulated, while there can be nothing but regret felt for those women, who, from any motive whatever, have opposed the Congress and endeavoured to injure it with those with whom they have influence, a course which has failed to achieve the desired object, while it must of necessity bring discredit on those who are so narrow-minded and ill-advised as to attempt to check a movement
