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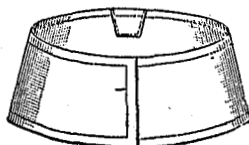

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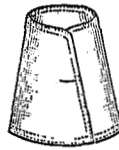

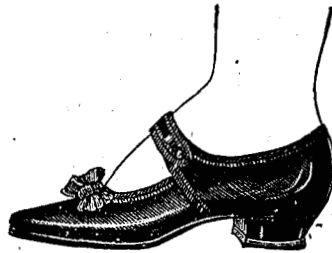


The "Sister Victoria" Cuff.
