The Progress of State Registra= tíon.

The letter from Dr. William Berry which we publish in another column, coming as it does from a medical man who has had special opportunities for studying the nursing question in his capacity of chairman of a large provincial hospital, will be read with interest by many. We have reason to believe that many hospital authorities in the provinces, as well as gentlemen in general practice, who come in contact with the evils resulting from the lack of organisation of nurses, share his views, and are prepared to support the efforts now being made by nurses to remedy these evils.

We do not wish to enter into controversial subjects in our Special Number, but we must briefly emphasise the fact that the opposition to the Registration movement comes from a small autocratic body in London, and is being engineered on purely official lines. Thus we learn that the procedure adopted with regard to the anti-Registration manifesto is to send it round to the secretaries of hospitals asking them to secure the signatures of members of the governing bodies, the medical staffs, and Matrons. It is significant that in the whole procedure the nurses have been absolutely ignored ; apparently the Central Hospital Council for London have not yet realised that nurses themselves have any right to express an opinion upon a matter which vitally affects them.

Another point which the public should take into consideration in estimating the value of the opposition is the right of this Council to adopt the position of an expert authority on nursing matters. It must be remembered that hospital committee men are not appointed to this honourable position as
