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As Others See Us.

As Miss Sophia Palmer says in last month's *American Journal of Nursing*, in emphasising the disloyalty of the nurses of Iowa:—"It is incredible that any body of intelligent women should deliberately cut themselves off from all possibility of creating for themselves, and for the nurses of their State, the position of a profession, for without self-government and the right to create the standards of nursing education, and to regulate the practice of nursing, professional recognition can never be attained. This action of the nurses of the State of Iowa goes to prove that we need not fear opposition from any outside body of people nearly so much as the ignorance or disloyalty of the women of our own profession."
