THE APRIL EXAMINATION.

At the examination of the Central Midwives' Board, held in London on April 3rd, 215 candidates presented themselves for examination; of these 169 passed, and 46 failed, making the percentage of failures 21.4.

The following list shows the schools in which the candidates received their training, and the results attained by the individual schools. Thirty-nine of the successful candidates gained their experience under private tuition.
