Much has also been done in the older part of the hospital to make the wards lighter, more bright and healthy. The operating theatres and suite have been brought up to date, and fitted with every modern appliance. Here for the first in the Hospital, it will be observed that the taunt of other days that only the "ugly duckling" took up nursing is amply disproved.

The Matron, Miss Scott, is very popular in Brighton, and head in affectionateregard by the nursing staff, who emulate her example in the fine old virtue of kindness. From personal experience I know that the

time I saw the stands containing deep glass basins i'n which the arms can be plunged up to the elbow in disinfectant, and which also hold glass cases for indiarubber gloves.

At the Sussex County Hospital, as in many country hospitals, the nurses do many of the surgical dressings, and wear gloves invariably when handling wounds, a precaution. which might well be adopted by other hospitals.

The Nursing School attached to the hospital is held in high esteem in the nursing world.
