Leeds Maternity Hospital.

At the annual meeting of the Leeds Maternity Hospital, at which the Lord Mayor, Alderman F. J. Kitson presided, the Hon. Secretary, Mrs. Robert Hudson, reported a generous legacy of £200 from the late Mr. Paul Hirsch, together with the receipts from various entertainments organised by some of the Ward Presidents; also the excellent work done by the Sewing Meeting Committee and their helpers, who had provided garments for the hospital and arranged sales of work in drawing-rooms, etc., and from many other friends interested in the work, which had enabled the Committee to declare the Hospital free from debt.

During the past year there had been a very large increase in the number of patients, both in the hospital and the Hunslet branch. Last year 144 patients were treated in the hospital, and 35 at Hunslet. This year the numbers had grown to 239 in the hospital, and 140 in the district—a total of 379 cases.

More advantage of the hospital had been taken by the medical practitioners of the city and district, many cases having been sent in on account of serious complications, or from extreme poverty. The work at the Hunslet branch had increased very considerably. The patients there were attended at their own homes.

The hospital, as a training school for midwives and nurses, had grown in favour. During the year 12 pupil midwives had received full training, and six more were now receiving training. Of these, eight had obtained the Central Midwives' Board certificate.

The Lady Mayoress was elected President of the General Committee, Miss Caroline March President of the Board of Management, Mrs. John Marshall hon. treasurer, Mrs. Robert Hudson and Mrs. B. Sykes Bailey Hon. Secretaries.
