MEETING OF THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE.

At the Meeting of the Central Committee for the State Registration of Trained Nurses, held in their Council Hall, 429, Strand, W.C., by the courtesy of the British Medical Association, on Saturday, February 28th, the eight affiliated Societies were well represented, and a very satisfactory report from the Executive Committee was discussed and adopted.

Dr. W. A. Chapple, M.P., who is now in charge of the Nurses' Registration Bill in the House of Commons, attended, and was elected a member of the Committee.

A very hearty vote of thanks, proposed by Sir Victor Horsley, F.R.C.S., F.R.S., and seconded by Mrs. Bedford Fenwick, was passed unanimously to Sir Ronald Munro Ferguson, G.C.M.G., P.C., for his invaluable services during the ten years he was in charge of the Bill.

Mrs. Fenwick said she specially desired to record the warm appreciation of the nurses for the unfailing interest, courtesy, and kindness of Sir Ronald Munro Ferguson during the many years he had championed their cause in the House of Commons.

Dr. Kenneth Trevor Stewart was nominated by the Royal British Nurses' Association as its fifth delegate to fill the vacancy caused by the death of Dr. Clement Godson.

The Committee discussed and adopted several recommendations calculated to advance materially the movement for the State Registration of Nurses.
