### EDITORIAL.

#### DIRECT REPRESENTATION.

ONE of the most ancient aphorisms in English law is that "representation and taxation must go together." The theory was debated and conceded at Runnymede, and embodied in Magna Charter in the form that no taxes should be levied except by consent of those who had to pay them. And through all the centuries since, the self-same principle has been constantly finding new expression and gradually permeating through our national life. In the State, from those distant days when the shire reeve was supposed to represent the county, through the extension of the franchise to class after class, down to our own time, when nearly every household can vote for the election of members of Parliament, and so, nominally, has a voice in the imposition of taxes and in the public expenditure, the growth of the idea is plain. In parochial matters, the extension of the vote has been equally manifest. And so, in like manner, the clear tendency of the English habit is exemplified in our social, philanthropic, and professional circles, and the accepted and invariable rule is that those who pay should have some financial control.

It is, at this present moment, most instructive to observe how in two different directions this deeply-rooted and ancient doctrine is being taught. In 1858, when the Medical Act was passed, Parliament appeared to break through the ordinary rule and to make a new departure. Because
