> THURSDAY, JULY 23RD. Next Meeting Place.

On Thursday, July 23rd, Miss ELDREDGE in the Chair, the first item taken was to consider the invitations received for the Next Meeting and Congress of the International Council of Nurses, and to decide where it should be held.

MISS JEAN E. BROWNE, R.N., President of the Canadian Nurses' Association, and MISS NINA D. GAGE, R.N., Chairman Educational Committee, Nurses' Association of China, endorsed the invitations of their respective Associations, and cordially invited the Council to meet in their countries.

MISS CORA SIMPSON, R.N., made

an eloquent appeal in favour of China as the next meeting place, stating that if the Congress were held in China it would be an inspiration to the whole country, that such inspiration was needed, and that its influence would be unbounded.

Miss Lillian Wu also supported the proposition, saying that China needed the International Council.

On being put to the vote the motion that the next Meeting and Congress of the International Council of Nurses should be held in China was carried by 24 votes to 17.

MISS GAGE expressed appreciation of this decision, and assured the Grand Council that China would heartily welcome the Delegates.
