Leaving a surplus of rather over £4,000. There is a possibility that upon this surplus Income Tax or perhaps Super Tax may be claimed. It seems also probable that the Council will have to provide an increasing scale of salaries for the staff. In any case the surplus Revenue is not more than is necessary for the proper provision for contingencies. Taking everything into consideration, your Committee estimate that at least a sum of £30,000 will be required for the current year.

The Committee then recommended:-

"That this Account of Balance Sheet be adopted and approved."

LADY HOBHOUSE enquired whether it was advisable to keep so large a sum as fro,000 on deposit, and The Chairman of the Finance Committee replied that it was a large sum, but most of it would be disbursed before the next meeting of the Council on July 16th.

The recommendation was carried, and the Auditor's Report was afterwards considered in camera.

Registration.

The Registration Committee reported that to June 4th applications received otherwise than by examination were 55,311. Approved by the Council to May 21st, 52,244. For approval on June 18th, 10 (General Register 6, Supplementary Registers, Male Nurses 1, Mental Nurses 2. Sick Children's Nurses 1). Ineligible to May 21st, 1,377. Duplicate applications, 483, Withdrawn 1,169, Incomplete 28

Applications for Registration by Examination had been 2,217. Passed, 1,806; Approved to May 21st, 1,793; Under age, 13; Referred in Examination, 411. Total 57,528.

The ten applications for registration found to be in conformity with the Rules were considered in camera.

The Council approved the Recommendation that the names of 25 Nurses who had hitherto failed to pay their Retention Fees, and now wished their names to be reincluded in the Register, should be re-included.

Education and Examination.

On the Recommendation of the Education and Examination Committee the following hospitals were recognised as training schools which, in combination with other Public Hospitals, give complete training under Section I (4) of the Scheme of Training:—

Bradford Royal Eye and Ear Hospital, in affiliation with

Bradford Royal Infirmary.

Liverpool Open-Air Hospital for Children, Leasowe, in

affiliation with Birkenhead Borough Hospital.

That the Buchanan Hospital, St. Leonards-on-Sea, be approved as a complete training school for a period of one year from June 18th, 1926.

The Committee reported an application from the authorities of the East Suffolk and Ipswich Hospital to have the State Examinations held at Ipswich. As the number of candidates from Ipswich justified the application the Committee recommended that an Examination Centre be established at Ipswich to be used alternately with the Centre at Norwich, and this was agreed.

CORRESPONDENCE, INTERVIEWS AND PERMITS.

The General Purposes Committee reported (a) that the correspondence dealt with in the office between April 1st and 3oth, amounted to 2,120 letters received, and 9,258 letters despatched; (b) that the interviews numbered 71; (c) that 132 Permits were issued for the State uniform. The Public Business then concluded, having lasted just six minutes.
