GENERAL NURSING COUNCIL FOR ENGLAND AND WALES.

The one hundred and ninth meeting of the General Nursing Council for England and Wales was held on Friday, January 24th, at 20, Portland Place, London, W.I., the Chairman, Miss E. M. Musson, C.B.E., R.R.C., presiding.

The minutes of the previous meeting having been con-firmed, the Chairman reported that it had been expected that the case of Annie Violet Tilt would have been heard at Bromsgrove on Tuesday, January 21st, but it had been postponed. This was a case which had been reported to the Public Prosecutor, and it had been supposed that he would take proceedings. He, however, considered that it would be better for the General Nursing Council to take action, and proceedings had accordingly been instituted.

Miss Musson further reported that the past year had been a very active one, 99 meetings of the Council and Committees having been held, and if no one had made every possible attendance it was because some of its number had been attending the Congress convened by the International Council of Nurses at Montreal in July, 1929. One or two matters were outstanding which the Council would like to have settled, but on the whole a satisfactory year's work had been accomplished.

The routine work had gone smoothly, and the increase was shown by the fact that 272 more nurses were registered by examination than in the previous year, and there were 573 more entrants for examination.
