## THE GENERAL NURSING COUNCIL FOR ENGLAND AND WALES.

A meeting of the General Nursing Council for England and Wales was held at the offices of the Council, 23, Portland Place, London, W.r, on September 27th.

## Finance.

On the recommendation of the Finance Committee, bills and claims submitted for payment were approved, and the sums of £680 for weekly salaries, £700 for postage, £60 for Insurance stamps, and £25 for petty cash were allowed. It was agreed that the Revenue Account and Balance

Sheet for the year ended March 31st, 1940, be adopted.

## Registration.

Applications for approval for Registration were : General Register, by reciprocity, 16; Supplementary Part of the Register for Mental Nurses, by reciprocity, 2; for Fever Nurses, by examination, 23, by reciprocity, 8. Total, 49.

It was agreed that 109 nurses who had hitherto failed to pay their retention fee and now wished their names reincluded in the Register, should be re-included.

## Education and Examination.

On the recommendation of the Education and Examination Committee, it was agreed that :-

The scheme of affiliation between Newark Town and District Hospital and Dispensary and Nottingham General Hospital be provisionally approved for a period of two years, or for the duration of the War, whichever is the less;

The Willesborough Hospital, Ashford, be provisionally approved (a) as a Training School in combination with the Royal Victoria Hospital, Folkestone (for the purposes of Probationers who have already started training at the latter hospital), and (b) as a Complete Training School for a period of two years, or for the duration of the War,

whichever is the less; The City General Hospital, Carlisle, be provisionally approved as a Complete Training School for a period of two years, or for the duration of the War, whichever is the less.

Correspondence was considered from the authorities concerning the amalgamation of the Bristol Royal Infirmary and the Bristol General Hospital, and it was agreed that the approval of these hospitals as Complete Training Schools be cancelled, but without prejudice to the position and rights of nurses already admitted thereto; and that the Bristol Royal Hospital be provisionally approved as a
