Complete Training School for a period of two years, or for

the duration of the War, whichever is the less.

An application from the authorities of the Borough General Hospital, Ipswich, for approval as a Complete Training School for Nurses, was considered, and provisionally approved for a period of two years, or for the duration of the War, whichever is the less. This hospital was approved under schemes of affiliation with Withington Hospital and Crumpsall Hospital, Manchester, and East Suffolk and Ipswich Hospital; these schemes of affiliation to be cancelled, but without prejudice to the position and rights of nurses already admitted thereto under the schemes.

It was agreed that the schemes of affiliation between Victoria Hospital, Accrington, and the Salford Royal Infirmary and Victoria Hospital for Burnley and District, be cancelled, but without prejudice to the position and rights of nurses already admitted thereto under the schemes, and that the Victoria Hospital, Accrington, be provisionally approved as a Complete Training School for Nurses for a period of two years, or for the duration of the War, whichever is the less.

It was agreed that the approval of the following affiliated hospitals as Training Schools be continued for a period of two years, or for the duration of the War, whichever is the less: Newton Abbot Hospital and the Royal Devon and

Exeter Hospital; Huntingdon County Hospital and the Bolingbroke Hospital, London; the Mildmay Memorial Hospital and the Metropolitan Hospital, London; King George's Sanatorium for Sailors, Liphook, and the Royal Hospital, Portsmouth.

It was agreed that the approval of the scheme of affiliation between the Maida Vale Hospital for Nervous Diseases, London, and the Royal Surrey County Hospital, Guildford, be cancelled, but without prejudice to the position and rights of nurses already admitted thereto under the scheme.

Correspondence from the Board of Education was considered, and it was agreed to approve the one-year wholetime Course of Instruction at Princess Mary High School, Halifax; the two-year part-time Course at the Wakefield Technical College; the one-year whole-time Course at the Harrow County School for Girls; and the one-year whole-time Course at Hawnes School, Hayners Park, Beds., for the purposes of Part I. of the Preliminary examination.

## Disciplinary and Penal Cases.

The Council then considered in camera the cases of three Registered Nurses reported by the police authorities, and two applications for the restoration of names to the Register.
