Mr. Eden, Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, speaking at Leeds on July 5th, at an open air mass meeting of more than 10,000 people, rejected outright any specious proposals

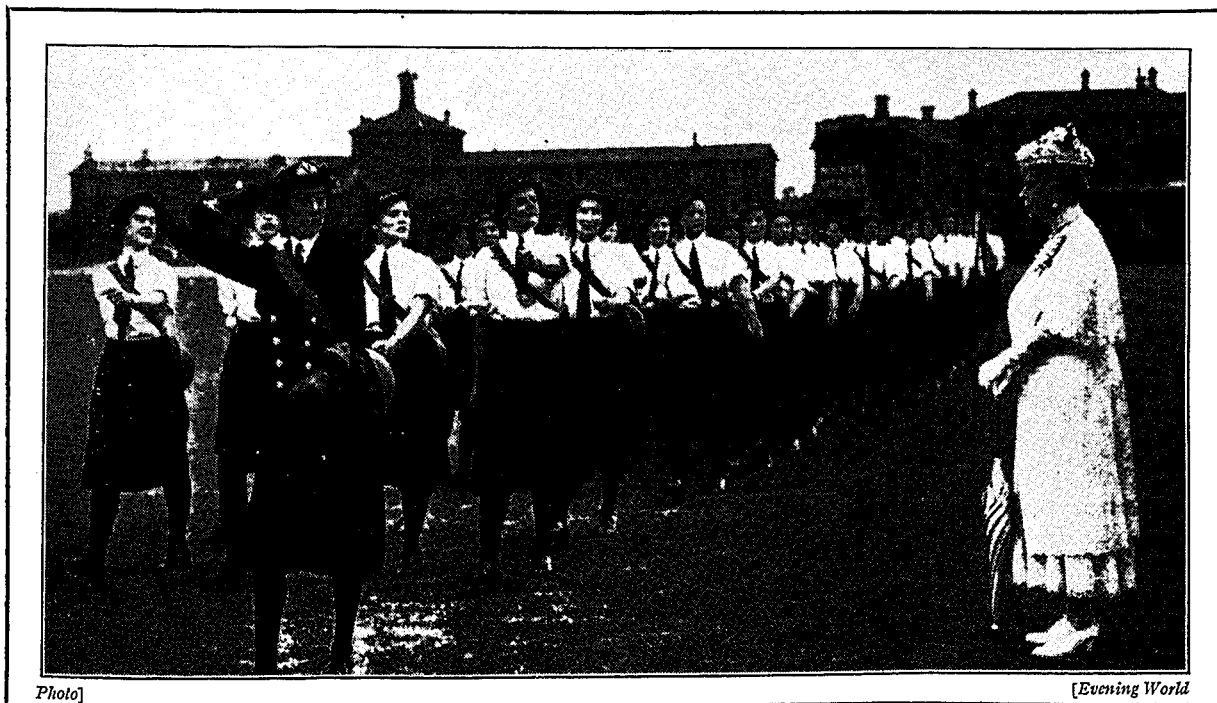
function on graduates' degree day when Lord Halifax, the British Ambassador, received the Honorary Degree of Doctor of Laws.

"Our lives are set in troublous days and the world is riven by argument whose weapons are not words but the most deadly instruments of man's devising," said Lord Halifax.

"What is being fought out to-day in Europe, Asia, and Africa, on the oceans and in the air, is whether or not those countries and the universities within them which have up to now called themselves free, shall be permitted to continue free and unfettered their fearless pursuit of knowledge.

"I could not prompt you to-day as to how you should think about this struggle, for that is a matter for individual conscience and the understanding of each one of us. You cannot but be helped, I am sure, to the right conclusion by the training you have received."

Dr. Arnold Whitridge, Master of Calhoun College, Yale, in a reference to Britain, said, "For the first time since
