" DISINFECTING

This preparation is a colourless aqueous solution of a fragrant odour, is non-poisonous, and does not stain linen. Being non-poisonous, it is the only Disinfectant which may be administered internally in cases of such diseases as Dysentery, Cholera and Typhoid Fever. Its active principles are those which are naturally generated in Pine and Eucalyptus Forests, and include Peroxide of Hydrogen, Thymol, a soluble Camphor, and other substances, which collectively give to it its pleasant pine-like odour. "Sanitas" Disinfecting Fluid is not merely a most effective **GERMICIDE** and antiseptic, but it is also a powerful oxidising agent; it prevents the formation of toxic products and also destroys them (by oxidation).

DIRECTIONS USE. FOR

- FOR CENERAL USE IN THE HOUSE :- Sprinkle about, or spray into the atmosphere. SPRAY PRODUCERS 2/6 EACH. ISOLATION OF THE SICK :-- Steep sheets or cloths in the Fluid, diluted with its own volume of water, wring out, and then hang them across the door of the infected apartment or sick room (one inside and one outside).
- IN CASES OF CHOLERA, DYSENTERY AND TYPHOID FEVER, doses (a tablespoonful in a wine glass filled up with water) of the Fluid should be given as a disinfectant, from time to time, under the direction of the medical attendant.
- IN SCARLET FEVER, and other diseases affecting the skin, the patient's body should be cold-sponged with the Fluid diluted with four times its own bulk of water, and a similar solution should be used for spraying or gargling the throat.

WASHING THE SICK :-- All water used for washing purposes should be rendered aseptic by the addition of, say, a wine-glass of the Fluid to each quart of water employed.

- WOUNDS AND SORES before dressing should be disinfected with the Fluid, after dilution with three times its own volume of
- IN CASES OF EAR DISCHARCES, NASAL DISEASE, SUPPURATING WOUNDS, SLOUCHING ULCERS, AND BURNS, the Fluid should be diluted with three times its own volume of water and applied by syringe, douche, bandage or spray producer to the seat. of the disease, as a disinfectant.
- IN BRONCHITIS AND SORE THROAT an antiseptic gargle, made by mixing one part of the Fluid with twice its own volume of water, should be used three or four times a day.
- AS AN ANTISEPTIC WASH FOR USE BY SURCEONS AND IN CONFINEMENTS the Fluid should be diluted with water (1:9.). It oxidises all putrid products and keeps wounds healthful without irritation or toxic effects. AS AN ANTI-PRURITIC the "Sanitas" Fluid diluted with three parts of water should be used for sponging.
- ALL SORES AND WOUNDS OF ANIMALS, such as broken shoulders, saddle galls, stable wounds, suppurative and ulcerous wouds &c., should be washed with a mixture of the Fluid with three times its own volume of water about twice a day, and always before dressing them.
- MANCE may be completely cured by washing the body of the affected animal several times a day with a mixture of the Fluid diluted with three times its own volume of water.
- FOOT AND MOUTH DISEASE :--Syringe out the mouth and throat of the animals with the Fluid diluted with three times its own volume of water twice a day, and wash the hoofs with the pure Fluid. Add also one wine-glass of the Fluid to each lot of drinking water.
- TO PRESERVE MEAT, FISH AND CAME :- Spray the articles once or twice a day with the Fluid diluted with three times its own volume of water.
- TO PRESERVE BEER IN THE HOUSE :- Add half a wine-glass to each nine (9) gallons.
- IN THE BATH AND WASHING WATER :-- Add the Fluid according to liking; it purifies the skin, oxidises all impurities, and greatly increases the luxury of the bath.
- AS A MOUTH AND TOOTH WASH :-- Use one tablespoonful to each wine-glass of water.
- OFFENSIVE BREATH :-- This unpleasantness is removed, no matter what the cause, by adding a tablespoonful of "Sanitas" to a wine-glass of water to be used as a mouth wash.
- TENDER AND PERSPIRING FEET are immediately relieved by bathing in diluted "Sanitas" Fluid (1 to 9 parts of water).
- FOR USE IN WATER CLOSETS :- A bottle of the Fluid should be kept in every closet, and a little of the Fluid should be poured into the pan every time the closet is used.

IN FINCER CLASSES AND FOUNTAINS a little of the Fluid should be added to the water used.

TO DESTROY CATERPILLARS AND APHIDES ON TREES, syringe with a mixture of one part "Sanitas" with nine parts water. STAINS ON WHITE COODS (Ink, Fruit, Wine Stains, &c.) are removed by moistening the spots with the "Sanitas" Fluid once or more as found necessary.
