**UPPA COCOA.**

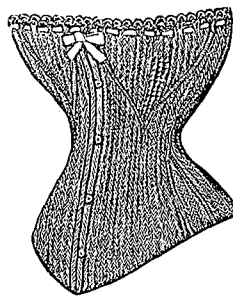

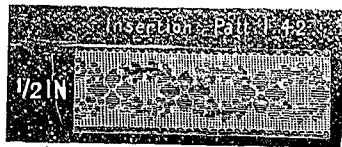
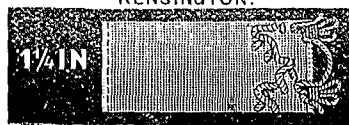
