THE GENERAL NURSING COUNCIL FOR ENGLAND AND WALES.

A Meeting of the General Nursing Council for England and Wales was held at the offices of the Council, 23, Portland Place, London, W., on October 22nd, 1943. Dame Ellen Musson, D.B.E., R.R.C., LL.D., presided.

Finance.

. On the recommendation of the Finance Committee, bills and claims submitted for payment were approved, and the sums of $\pounds1,400$ for Weekly Salaries, $\pounds500$ for Postage, $\pounds60$ for Insurance Stamps, and $\pounds20$ for Petty Cash were allowed.

It was reported that the Finance Committee has carried out the request of the Council to consider the position in regard to presenting an estimate of income and expenditure for the approval of the Council ; but in view of the difficulty in drawing up any accurate estimate at the present time, the Committee is not now in a position to make a statement, but will be prepared to reconsider the matter before the end of the financial year, March 31st, 1944. This was agreed.

Registration.

Applications for approval for Registration were : General Register, by reciprocity, 4; Supplementary Part of the Register for Mental Nurses, by reciprocity, 4; for Sick

Children's Nurses, by reciprocity, 2; Fever Nurses, by examination, 17, by reciprocity, 5. Total, 32.

It was agreed that 84 nurses, who have hitherto failed to pay their retention fee, and now wish their names reincluded in the Register, shall be re-included.

It was agreed that an Election of Council take place in December, 1944, provided that the requisite supply of paper can be procured, and that the additional staff necessary for the work is obtainable.

It was reported that copies of Registers have been re-ceived from the Nurses' Board of Victoria, and the Madras Nurses and Midwives' Council.

Education and Examination.

It was reported that the Education and Examination Committee has considered the letter from the Ministry of Labour and National Service, and is of opinion that the time is not yet opportune for putting into force the suggestions of the Ministry of Labour and National Service as to compulsory training in tuberculosis nursing, and that the statements on this matter embodied in the letter to the Ministry of Labour and National Service, dated August 19th, 1943, should be re-affirmed.

Approval of Hospitals as affiliated Training Schools for Nurses, continuation of approval of Hospitals as Training Schools for Nurses and Pre-Nursing Courses were agreed.
