

General Purposes.

The purchase of equipment for the Assistant Nurses' Department to the value of £472 7s. was agreed.

An estimate of £83 for painting railings to balconies, areas and steps was accepted.

Assistant Nurses' Committee.

It was reported that a Sub-Committee consisting of Miss R. Dreyer, Mrs. W. L. Ford, Miss L. Snowden and Miss E. C. Pearce has been appointed to consider the course of instruction to be set up for future Assistant Nurses and the type of examination.

Disciplinary Cases.

The case of Catherine Mary Harrington, S.R.N., 55,978, was before the Council. She appeared before the County of London Sessions for stealing linen from University

College Hospital. She received a sentence of two months' imprisonment.

The Council considered the case *in camera*, and the Registrar was instructed to remove her name from the Register of Nurses.

The case of Jeanne McDougal, S.R.N., 114,558, was considered. She was charged at Stratford Petty Sessions with obtaining the sum of £3 from a Post Office Savings Book by means of forging a signature, and was fined £15 or six weeks' imprisonment.

The Council considered the case *in camera*, and agreed that her name be removed from the Register of Nurses.

The case of Margaret Lumsden Grant Robertson, S.R.N., 107,886, was before the Council. She had been bound over at Bury in the sum of £5, under the Probation of Offenders' Act, for stealing a cigarette case containing cigarettes, £2
