Proposed Additions and Amendments to the Rules of the Council.

It was reported that additions and amendments to the rules have been considered by the appropriate committee and are recommended for approval.

Draft amendments to the rules have been laid before Council and approved, and now require formal approval for submission to the Minister of Health.

It will be realised that the General Nursing Council has actively in preparation schemes of training for admission to the Register, and amendments to the rules. Its decision, therefore, to summon a Conference in November, 1944, for discussion of the revised Syllabuses of Subjects for Examination for admission to the various parts of the Register, and a Comprehensive Scheme of Training will be welcomed, as the term of office of the present Council terminates at an early date.

THE FORTHCOMING ELECTION.

Owing to war conditions, the General Nursing Council for England and Wales postponed the Election of Council which should have been held in 1942, for two years.
