# THE GENERAL NURSING COUNCIL FOR ENGLAND AND WALES.

A meeting of the General Nursing Council for England and Wales was held at the offices of the Council, 23, Portland Place, London, W., on December 17th, 1943.

#### Finance.

On the recommendation of the Finance Committee, bills and claims submitted for payment were approved, and the sums of £1,150 for weekly salaries, £400 for postage, £60 for insurance stamps, £20 for petty cash, and £5,000 for examiners' claims were allowed.

Estimates for stationery of £297 1s. and for 200 copies of Register of Nurses for 1944 of £5,167 2s. 10d. were agreed.

#### Registration.

Applications for approval for Registration were: General Part of the Register, by examination, 268, by reciprocity, 3; Supplementary Part of the Register for Male Nurses, by examination, 4; for Mental Nurses, by examination, 2, by reciprocity, 3; for Sick Children's Nurses, by examination, 14, by reciprocity, 1; for Favor Nurses, by examination, 14, by reciprocity, 1; for Fever Nurses, by examina-tion, 43, by reciprocity, 3. Total, 341.

It was agreed that 85 nurses who had hitherto failed to pay their retention fee, and now wished their names re-

included in the Register, should be re-included.
