A Fairy Story Come to Life: 20th November, 1947

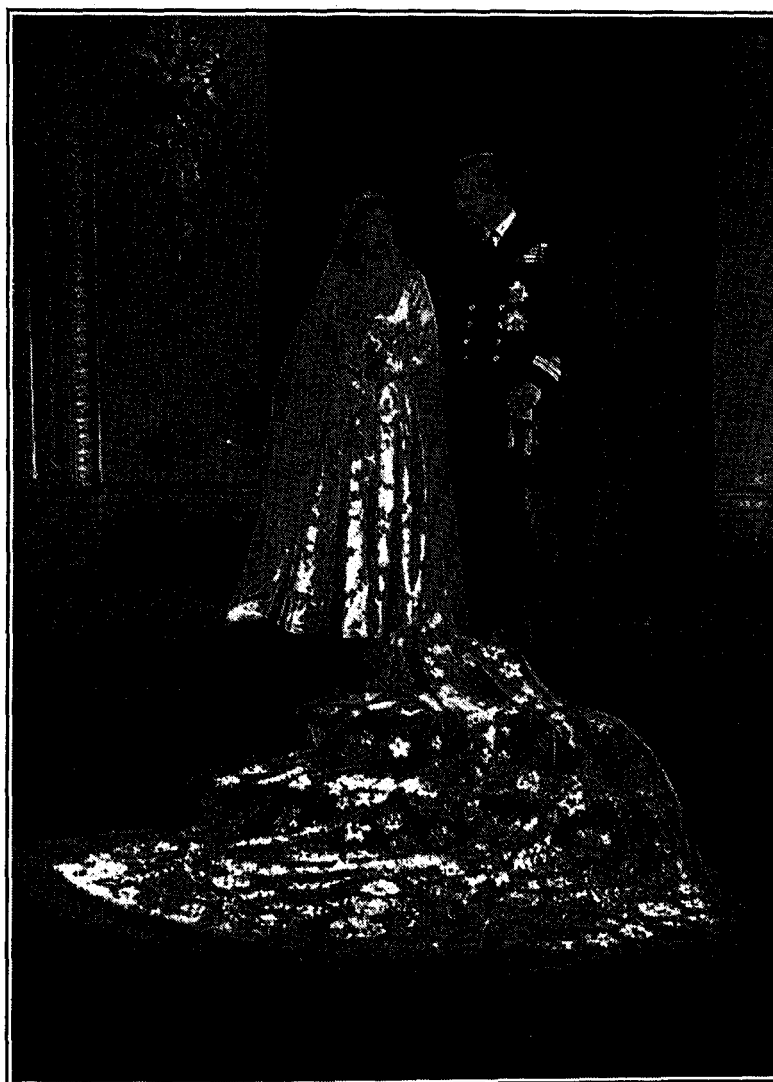
