Training Schools for Fever Nurses are concerned, the Council's requirement regarding the daily average occupation of beds be not implemented at the present time, and consideration of the future status of such Hospitals be deferred until February 1st, 1949, and that authorities of such Hospitals be informed to this effect.

Approval as a Complete Training School has been restored to the Tilbury Hospital, Tilbury; Wilson Hospital, Mitcham; and Wimbledon Hospital, as a result of steps taken to increase the bed complement and the daily occupation of beds.

It was reported that Miss R. Munday, S.R.N., R.S.C.N., has resigned from the Board of Examiners for the Final Examination for Sick Children's Nurses; and Miss O. Edwards, S.R.N., R.S.C.N., D.N., Sister Tutor, Liverpool Children's Hospital, Heswall, Cheshire, has been appointed to the Board.

## Mental Nursing.

It was recommended that the suggestion of the Minister of Health be accepted that, as an interim arrangement pending legislation for the establishment of the proposed Mental Nurses Board, five persons with Mental qualifica-
