

WE HAVE MUCH PLEASURE in presenting a reproduction of part of a remarkable stained glass window placed in Blofield Church, Norwich, to the memory of Margaret Gordon Harker, in 1936, by her husband.

The Vicar of Blofield Church tells us that Mrs. Harker was an enthusiastic worker for the Red Cross and held many appointments in the County of Norfolk. She also built and endowed a Red Cross Hut for the use of the local branch as well as building and presenting to the village the Village Hall, which is now known as the Margaret Harker Memorial Hall.

William Harker engaged Messrs. Clayton and Bell to put two stained glass windows on the South side of the church, and their bright colourings make a fine addition to the beauty of the church, which is a very fine one.

The main subjects of the two windows are the Washing of the Disciples' Feet and the Blessing of the Children.

Below these main pictures there are three small panels in each window, dealing with Red Cross and St. John's Ambulance subjects. The first is a War Hospital, the second is a Red Cross First Aid Post, the third is St. John's Ambulance in action near Blofield Church; under the second window the first is a Baby Clinic, the second is the Yarmouth Fisher Girls at work, which we here present, and the third is the Junior Red Cross members under instruction.

Anyone who has seen the Fisher Girls will realise that the speed at which they work means that it is possible for cut hands to be numerous, and it has been part of

the work done by the Norfolk Red Cross, over a period of years, to run a Clinic for these girls during the herring season. It seems fitting that some of the practical ways in which the teaching of Our Lord has been applied in our modern life should be commemorated in a Church in windows placed there in memory of one who had Red Cross work so much at heart.
