WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL.**STUDENT HEALTH VISITORS.**

Applications are invited from State Registered General Trained Nurses holding the Certificate of the Central Midwives Board or the 1st Certificate under the new C.M.B. rules. Successful candidates will be required to pass a medical examination.

The engagement will be for 12 months and will comprise approximately nine months' training for the Health Visitor's Certificate in Birmingham, beginning in September, 1951, followed by three months' work in the public health service in Worcestershire. During the preliminary period the payment made to each student health visitor will be three-quarters of the minimum salary and uniform allowance for a health visitor, namely, £277 10s. plus £9 uniform allowance.

Assisted candidates must undertake to give, if required, at the end of the training a further 12 months' service as a health visitor in Worcestershire. The salary would be that of a Health Visitor in accordance with the Whitley Council scale, i.e., £370 rising to £495 per annum plus uniform allowance.

Applications, on a form obtained from the County Medical Officer, County Buildings, Worcester, must be returned together with two recent testimonials, not later than March 10th, 1951.
