PRINCESS ELIZABETH, who is Colonel of the Grenadier Guards, took the salute at the Trooping the Colour Ceremony on the Horse Guards Parade in honour of the King's official birthday, on June 7th, 1951.

Her courageous demeanour as she rode in the scarlet tunic of the Grenadier Guards, bearskin tricorne hat,

splendidly mounted on Winston, a light chestnut police horse, in all his ceremonial Grenadier trappings, aroused tremendous admiration and cheering from immense crowds on every side.
